PER CURIAM.

Guatemalan citizen Francisca Batz-Vicente petitions for review of an order of the Board of Immigration Appeals (BIA), which affirmed an immigration judge's denial of asylum and withholding of removal.¹ We conclude substantial evidence supports the BIA's determination that Batz-Vicente did not meet her burden of proof

for asylum because she did not establish either past persecution or a well-founded fear of future persecution on account of a protected ground. <u>See Khrystotodorov v.</u> <u>Mukasey</u>, 551 F.3d 775, 781 (8th Cir. 2008) (standard of review); <u>Makatengkeng v.</u> <u>Gonzales</u>, 495 F.3d 876, 883 (8th Cir. 2007); <u>Ahmed v. Ashcroft</u>, 396 F.3d 1011, 1014-15 (8th Cir. 2005). Because Batz-Vicente failed to meet the lower burden of proof on her asylum claim, her claim for withholding of removal must fail as well. <u>See Gitimu v. Holder</u>, 581 F.3d 769, 774 (8th Cir. 2009).

Accordingly, we deny the petition.
