Carlos Calhoun, currently incarcerated in federal prison after escaping from an Iowa work release program, appeals the district court's¹ adverse grant of summary judgment in his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action. After careful de novo review, *see Johnson v. Blaukat*, 453 F.3d 1108, 1112 (8th Cir. 2006), we affirm for the reasons stated by
