PER CURIAM.

Arkansas inmate Charles Ashford appeals the district court's¹ dismissal of his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action against the Arkansas Department of Correction (ADC) and Ray Hobbs.² Upon de novo review, <u>see Saunders v. Farmers Ins. Exch.</u>, 537 F.3d 961,
