PER CURIAM.

Steven Blair appeals the district court's<sup>1</sup> dismissal of two private individuals, Patty Dory and Lori Anzaldo, who were named as defendants in his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action.<sup>2</sup> After careful review, we conclude that the claims in question are precluded

by the doctrine of res judicata, as these defendants were dismissed with prejudice in a prior action brought by Blair. Blair v. Anderson, D. Neb. No. 4:04-cv-03229, R. Docs. No. 42, 57. Accordingly, we affirm, and we deny all pending motions.
