PER CURIAM.

In this action removed from state court to federal court, Nicholas Weimer appeals after the district court¹ denied his motion for leave to amend his complaint, granted a motion to dismiss for failure to state a claim, and ruled adversely on crossmotions for summary judgment. After carefully reviewing the record and the parties' arguments on appeal, we find no basis for reversal. <u>See Harris v. FedEx Nat'1 LTL,</u> <u>Inc.</u>, 760 F.3d 780, 786 (8th Cir. 2014) (denial of leave to amend is reviewed for abuse of discretion); <u>Rochling v. Dep't of Veterans Affairs</u>, 725 F.3d 927, 930 (8th Cir. 2013) (dismissal for failure to state claim is reviewed de novo); <u>Humphries v.</u> <u>Pulaski Cnty. Special Sch. Dist.</u>, 580 F.3d 688, 692 (8th Cir. 2009) (decision on cross-motions for summary judgment is reviewed de novo). Accordingly, we affirm the judgment. <u>See</u> 8th Cir. R. 47B.
