conditions. The court revoked supervised release and imposed a within-Guidelines-range revocation sentence of 11 months in prison. On appeal, Dunbar contends that the sentence is substantively unreasonable. Upon careful review of the record, we conclude that the court did not abuse its discretion. See <u>United States v. Miller</u>, 557 F.3d 910, 915-16 (8th Cir. 2009) (standard of review). The judgment is affirmed, and we grant counsel leave to withdraw.
