sentenced her to a below-Guidelines-range prison term. Her counsel has moved for leave to withdraw, and has filed a brief under <u>Anders v. California</u>, 386 U.S. 738 (1967).

We have reviewed the record to determine whether the appeal waiver is valid, see <u>United States v. Scott</u>, 627 F.3d 702, 704 (8th Cir. 2010) (de novo review of validity of appeal waiver), and whether there are any nonfrivolous issues for appeal, see <u>Penson v. Ohio</u>, 488 U.S. 75 (1988) (independent review of record in <u>Anders cases</u>). We conclude that the appeal waiver is valid and enforceable and that there are no nonfrivolous issues outside the scope of the waiver. <u>See United States v. Andis</u>, 333 F.3d 886, 890-92 (8th Cir. 2003) (en banc) (discussing enforcement of appeal waivers). We grant counsel's motion to withdraw, and we dismiss the appeal.
