PER CURIAM.

Tonias Overton directly appeals the sentence the district court¹ imposed upon revoking his supervised release. His counsel has moved for leave to withdraw and has filed a brief questioning the reasonableness of Overton's revocation sentence.

After careful review of the record, we conclude the district court did not abuse its discretion in sentencing Overton. See <u>United States v. Miller</u>, 557 F.3d 910, 915-18 (8th Cir. 2009) (standard of review); see also <u>United States v. Perkins</u>, 526 F.3d 1107, 1110-11 (8th Cir. 2008) (this court reviews entire sentencing record, not merely district court's statements at hearing).

We grant counsel's motion for leave to withdraw and affirm the judgment of the district court.
