PER CURIAM.

Donnie Ray Dumas appeals after the District Court¹ granted summary judgment to defendants in his action brought under <u>Bivens v. Six Unknown Named Agents of</u>

<u>Fed. Bureau of Narcotics</u>, 403 U.S. 388 (1971). Viewing the summary judgment record in the light most favorable to Dumas and drawing all reasonable inferences in his favor, we agree with the District Court that summary judgment was warranted. <u>See Clay v. Credit Bureau Enters., Inc.</u>, 754 F.3d 535, 539 (8th Cir. 2014) (standard of review). We further conclude that the court did not err in denying Dumas's motion to add a habeas claim against the United States Parole Commission. <u>See Kozlov v.</u> <u>Associated Wholesale Grocers, Inc.</u>, 818 F.3d 380, 394–95 (8th Cir. 2016) (standard of review). We affirm the judgment.
