(FOIA) action. Having carefully reviewed the record and the parties' arguments on appeal, we find no error in the district court's decision. See Miller v. U.S. Dep't of State, 779 F.2d 1378, 1382 (8th Cir. 1985) (in FOIA cases, grant of summary judgment is appropriate where "the agency proves that it has fully discharged its obligations under FOIA, after the underlying facts and inferences to be drawn from them are construed in the light most favorable to the FOIA requester"). Accordingly, the judgment is affirmed. See 8th Cir. R. 47B.
