PER CURIAM.

George Sullivan appeals following the district court's<sup>1</sup> adverse grant of summary judgment in his 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action. After careful review of the record, we find no basis for reversal. *See Morris v. Craddock*, 954 F.3d 1055, 1058 (8th Cir. 2020) (reviewing de novo grant of summary judgment); *Cooper v. Schriro*, 189 F.3d 781, 783 (8th Cir. 1999) (per curiam) (reviewing de novo 28 U.S.C. § 1915A dismissal). Accordingly, we affirm. *See* 8th Cir. R. 47B. We also deny Sullivan's pending motion.
