Any party objecting to video recording must file its opposition, not to exceed 1,200 words, no later than 4:00 p.m., PST, on Friday, January 7, 2011. Information submitted to the court under seal may have since become public knowledge. The parties may each file a motion to unseal specific parts of the briefs and excerpts of record. Motions must be filed no later than 9:00 a.m., PST, on Monday, January 10, 2011, and may not exceed 1,200 words. Appended to each motion must be a list (1) identifying by page number the items to unseal and (2) providing a publicly available source for each item, if possible. Any opposition must be filed no later than 4:00 p.m., PST, on Monday, January 10, 2011, and may not exceed 1,200 words.
