Zarrillo Pursuant to Ninth Circuit Rule 32-2, Plaintiffs-Appellees respectfully request leave to file an answering brief in excess of the applicable type-volume limitation. *See* Fed. R. App. P. 32(a)(7)(B). In order to respond to Appellants' 30,315-word opening brief, Plaintiffs-Appellees request leave to file an answering brief of no more than 27,000 words. Leave to exceed the type-volume limitation is warranted in light of the necessity for Plaintiffs-Appellees to respond to Appellants' over-length brief and to the additional arguments regarding the constitutionality of Proposition 8 advanced by the County of Imperial in appeal No. 10-16751 and by Appellants' more than two dozen *amici*.
