

Since the early 1980s, the Les Paul SG Standard has been Gibson's premier double cutaway solid-body electric. The eatra slim, fast, low-action neck, aggressive styling, and thin, lightweight mahogany body have made it a favorite among guitarists for decades.

This instrument has been engineered and manufactured to the same specifications as the original model and reflects the sharp contoured carving, dramatic scarling and an overlapping heel neck joint. The peghead has been restored to its original specification and features a holly head veneer.

The Les Paul SG Standard Reissue is available with either a long Maestro tailpiece or stopbur tailpiece.


