Thankfully, the folks at Pop ChartLab are bringing beauty, order and a little bit of biology to rap. Pompadour and circumstances

Morrissey—the man, his voice and his music—is most brilliant in small doses. At some point he's going to put his foot in his mouth or you'll reach for a noose. Which is why the format of *Mozzella: The Encyclopedia of Morrissey and the Smiths* (Plume Books, \$30) works so well. The reference-tome approach is perfect for such a mercurial and guarded subject. Simon Goddard has exhaustively researched every song of King Moque, and he's refreshingly critical. Entries cover all the kitchen-sink films, melodrama actresses and girl groups that populate his milieu. Who knew he was obsessed with Bea Arthur? Available at most bookstores.

Thinner Lizzy

Air guitar is finally a legitimate instrument with *Paper Jamz* (\$25). (There are Paper Jamz to plug in to and drum pads, too.) The Gibson replica, pictured, comes preloaded with crummy hillbilly ditties. Instead, nab the flying V model to strum along to the Ramones, BOC and Helen. Or, in freestyle mode, you can legitimately string together rudimentary barre chords and go your own way. The distorted digital crunch sounds better than the guitars on the new No Age album. 
Paperback rocker: Paper Jamz guitars and drums

Well now you can strum away to your heart's content — or beat away, if drumming is your thing — on paper-thin electronic instruments.

Okay, maybe they're not quite authentic enough to actually start a band with, but they're more than suited to a quick play around in your house when your partner's not around.



WowWee have released their range of Paper Jamz guitars — as well as drums and guitar amplifiers — that promise musical inspiration at the flick of a wrist. The main draw are the guitars, retailing at £24.99, which make authentic guitar noise when strummed. There's a whole host of functions here, letting you freestyle and also play along with three pre-loaded rock anthems, including the likes of Deep Purple's 'Smoke on the Water'.

These things are tiny — as little as 3mm in bulk — but are shaped just like the real thing, letting you play on a Gibson Flying V or a Fender Strat without having to shell out hundreds of pounds.

But not only can you axe-grind, you can also tub thump. Also priced at £24.99, the Paper Jamz drum-kit is a ten-

FANS OF GUITAR HERO, GET THIS!!!!

It's called Paper Jamz cos it's 'paper thin' but it's really a thin plastic guitar toy.

I got the rock 2 (red gibson style). It's fun to mess around with! I use it to play songs just for kicks until I get around to buying strings for my real guitar (and eventually learn how to play!)

The guitars came with three songs to learn. My guitar came with What I Like About You by the Romantics, Two Princes by the Spin Doctors, and It's the End of the World As We Know It by R.E.M. There are different modes on the guitar: play 1, play 2, and play 3: freestyle, rhythm 1, rhythm 2, and rhythm 3. The play modes play the backing tracks and vocals of the songs that you "strum" along to. Rhythm mode controls the rhythm of the guitar accompanying the hits. Freestyle mode is awesome. I get to play notes by pressing a fret or major/minor chords by holding down two or more frets (there's a few 7th chords too) and create my own songs! The chords are in open E. There's a Karaoke mode to learn how to play the included songs better, how cool!

You can adjust the volume by pressing and holding down the volume button, then slide your fingers up the neck of the guitar. To turn it down, you press and hold volume, then slide your fingers down.

There's a jack for audio or line out. Having a line out jack is awesome cos then you can play along to your own songs from your mp3 player or whatever audio source! It comes with a manual which is very thorough in English, Spanish, and French, and has a mini card of the 'chords' you can play on your guitar.

This takes 3 AAA (triple-A) batteries.

It's not a real guitar by any means, but it's fun to pretend! Now I need my paper jamz amp (yes there is one) and I can really ROCK OUT!!! I use freestyle mode often to
