2	1049, 1056 (9th Cir. 2009), and we deny the petition for review.
3	Substantial evidence supports the agency's finding that Gramajo Rodas
4	failed to establish he was harmed by the army and guerillas on account of a
5	protected ground, including his political neutrality. See Sangha v. INS, 103 F.3d
6	1482, 1487-89 (9th Cir. 1997); see also INS v. Elias-Zacarias, 502 U.S. 478, 482-
7	83 (1992). Thus, his claims for asylum and withholding of removal fail.
