We represent Defendant-Appellant/Cross-Appellee Conseco Life Insurance Company ("Conseco") in the above-captioned matter. Pursuant to Rule 28(j) of the Federal Rules of Appellate Procedure and Circuit Rule 28-6, we write to submit *Mazza v. American Honda Motor Co.*, No. 09-55376, 2012 WL 89176 (9th Cir. Jan. 12, 2012) as supplemental authority in support of Conseco's appeal.

In *Mazza*, this Court held that "[n]o class may be certified that contains members lacking Article III standing." 2012 WL 89176, at \*10 (quoting *Denney v. Deutsche Bank AG*, 443 F.3d 253, 264 (2d Cir. 2006)). *Mazza* therefore supports Conseco's argument that all class members must satisfy Article III's standing requirements, and the district court erred in holding that only Plaintiff-Appellee/Cross-Appellant Yue had to have standing. *See* Conseco's Main Brief on Appeal at 35-36 (standing required for all class members) and Conseco's Third Brief on Cross Appeal at 33 n.19 (same).

We respectfully request that this supplemental authority be brought to the Panel's attention.
