Briefly describe the result below and the main issues on appeal.

Appellee's motion to dismiss and abstain was granted by the district court on the basis of two separate abstention doctrines as set forth in O'Shea v. Littleton, 414 U.S. 488 (1974) and Railroad Commission of Texas v. Pullman Co., 312 U.S. 496 (1941). Courthouse News now appeals the district court's order and disputes that either of those two abstention doctrines are applicable to this case.
