As discussed in slip opinion 15-144 (Dec. 21, 2015), the plaintiff, Toscelik Profil ve Sac Endustrisi A.S. ("Toscelik"), persuaded that remand of *Circular Welded Carbon Steel Pipes And Tubes From Turkey: Final Results of Countervailing Duty Administrative Review; Calendar Year* 2012 and Rescission of Countervailing Duty Administrative Review, in Part, 79 Fed.
