
ORDER

On March 16, 2020, the American Civil Liberties Union, the American Civil Liberties Union of the District of Columbia, and the Media Freedom and Information Access Clinic (Movants) filed an unopposed motion to enlarge the time for Movants to respond to the Order to Show Cause entered on March 13, 2020 (Motion). The Court finds good cause in accordance with Rule 11(d) of this Court's Rules of Procedure to extend the time for Movants' response.

Accordingly, the Motion is GRANTED IN PART. The parties are HEREBY ORDERED to submit their briefs on the following revised schedule:

- a. Movants shall now file their brief by April 9, 2020; and
- b. The government shall file its responsive brief, if any, by April 13, 2020.
