Accordingly, it is hereby ORDERED that the briefing schedule in this matter is revised as follows: any response by the Government to Microsoft Corporation's Motion for Declaratory Judgment or Other Appropriate Relief Authorizing Disclosure of Aggregate Data Regarding FISA Orders must be submitted no later than 5:00 p.m. on August 13, 2013. If the Government responds, Microsoft Corporation may file a reply brief no later than 5:00 p.m. on August 20, 2013, through the Security and Emergency Planning Staff, U.S. Department of Justice.
