ORDER

This case is before the court on the Recommendation of the Magistrate Judge (Doc. #22), entered on September 11, 2014, and the Petitioner’s Objection thereto (Doc. #25).

Following an independent evaluation and *de novo* review of the entire file in this case, the court finds the objection to be without merit. The Petitioner merely objects with conclusory statements to the Magistrate Judge’s determination in various paragraphs in the Recommendation. ORDERED that Petitioner’s objection is OVERRULED, the court ADOPTS the Recommendation of the Magistrate Judge, and this petition for habeas corpus relief is DENIED.
