OPINION and ORDER

On July 11, 2019, the Magistrate Judge entered a Recommendation recommending that the decision of the Commissioner be affirmed. (Doc. 22). On July 25, 2019, the Plaintiff filed objections to the Recommendation. (Doc. 23).

The Court has carefully reviewed the Plaintiff's Objections, the Recommendation of the Magistrate Judge, and the administrative record. The Plaintiff's Objections largely mirror his brief, and reiterate his claims presented in his complaint. The Plaintiff does not point to any error committed by the Magistrate Judge. The Court finds that the wellreasoned Recommendation of the Magistrate Judge effectively addresses all of the Plaintiff's claims.
