**ORDER**

Plaintiff is incarcerated in the Coosa County Jail located in Rockford, Alabama. She files the instant 42 U.S.C. § 1983 action alleging a violation of her Fourteenth Amendment right to right to equal protection. Plaintiff names the Coosa County Jail as the sole defendant.

Plaintiff's complaint has been accepted for filing. However, her complaint against the Coosa County Jail may not go forward as this entity is not subject to suit or liability in a complaint filed under 42 U.S.C. § 1983. *See Dean v. Barber*, 951 F.2d 1210, 1214 (11<sup>th</sup> Cir. 1992). Accordingly, before further proceedings in this matter are conducted, the court deems it appropriate to direct Plaintiff to amend her complaint to name the defendant(s) responsible for the alleged violation of her constitutional rights.

*Pro se* complaints are held to a less stringent standard than those drafted by attorneys, and a complainant who submits an unartfully plead action which contains a potentially
