OPINION

Pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983, plaintiff Rocky Jones filed this lawsuit charging defendants Neil Bradley and Tony Harrison with excessive force during an arrest. This lawsuit is now before the court on the recommendation of the United States Magistrate Judge that, based on the evidence presented during an evidentiary hearing as well as the record in the case, judgment should be entered in favor of the defendants and against the plaintiff.
