ORDER

The plaintiff has filed a *Bivens*-type complaint¹ alleging a violation of his constitutional rights by the U.S Attorney General and U.S. Probation Commissioner. (Doc. No. 1.) The plaintiff has also filed a motion for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis* in this action. (Doc. No. 2.) Although the plaintiff submitted an affidavit in support of his motion for leave to proceed *in forma pauperis*, it is not accompanied by the requisite account information from the account clerk at the Lee County Detention Center, where the plaintiff is currently incarcerated. Pursuant to the fee provisions of 28 U.S.C. § 1915(b)(1), this court requires a plaintiff to submit an inmate account statement reflecting the average monthly balance in his prison account and the average monthly deposits to his account for the six-month period immediately preceding the filing of a complaint. The plaintiff shall therefore be granted additional time to provide this court with current information regarding his inmate account so the court may determine whether he should be allowed to proceed *in*
