ORDER

This cause is before the Court on the Estate's Second Renewed Application and Motion for Attorney's Fees, Expenses, and Costs Under the Equal Access to Justice Act (Doc. 308).¹ United States Magistrate Judge Susan Russ Walker submitted a report recommending the motion be denied.
