## OPINION AND ORDER

Before the court is plaintiff's motion to dismiss certain grounds. He requests dismissal of challenges made regarding five disciplinaries he received on August 23, 2013, for an incident which occurred at the Bullock Correctional Facility on August 22, 2003.
