ORDER

- 3. Plaintiff's claim for monetary damages against Defendant Dillard is DISMISSED with prejudice prior to service of process under 28 U.S.C. § 1915(e)(2)(B)(iii).
 - 4. This case is referred back to the Magistrate Judge for further proceedings.
