OPINION

Pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983, plaintiff Rhonda Ward, a former employee of the Elmore County Commission, naming as defendants the commission and its members and asserting violations of her federal rights to equal protection and substantive and procedural due process in the handling of her termination appeal. She also brings a state claim for failure to train and supervise against the commission.
