OPINION

Pursuant to Bivens v. Six Unknown Federal Narcotics Agents, 403 U.S. 388 (1971), and the Administrative Procedures Act, 5 U.S.C. §§ 551-559, plaintiff, a federal prisoner, filed this case challenging the adequacy of the Montgomery Federal Prison Camp's law library, and specifically the decision to discard the American Jurisprudence treatise series and to take away certain electronic typewriters with memory and replace them with simple manual ones.
