ORDER

Now pending before the court is the Recommendation of the Magistrate Judge (Doc. 81) which recommends that the Defendants’ motion for summary judgment (Docs. 36, 41, 49, and 51) be granted, the judgment be granted in favor of Defendants, and that Plaintiff’s Complaint (Doc. 1) be dismissed with prejudice with costs taxed against Plaintiff.
