OPINION and ORDER

On September 5, 2018, the Magistrate Judge entered a Recommendation granting the defendants’ motion to dismiss the amended complaint (doc. # 41), denying as moot the defendants’ motion to dismiss (doc. # 12) and dismissing the plaintiff’s claims with prejudice. *See* Doc. # 46. On September 19, 2018, the plaintiff filed objections to the order of the Magistrate Judge. *See* Doc. # 48. 4. The defendants' motion to dismiss the amended complaint (doc. # 41) be and is hereby GRANTED
5. This case be and is hereby DISMISSED with prejudice.
