ORDER

Before the court is Plaintiff Pennsylvania National Insurance Company’s (“Penn National”) Motion to Transfer Venue. Doc. 23. On November 23, 2015, the court ordered Defendants James Munford and Jeffrey Easy to show cause, in writing, as to why the venue of this matter should not be transferred to the Eastern Division of the Middle District of Alabama, as requested by Penn National in its motion. *See* Doc. 24. Neither Defendant responded to the court’s show cause order. Having received no objection from either Defendant, and after careful consideration of Penn National’s motion, the court finds that venue for this action is proper in the Eastern Division of the Middle District of Alabama.¹ Therefore, it is ORDERED that Penn National’s motion (Doc. 23) is GRANTED, and this case is TRANSFERRED to the Eastern Division of the Middle

District of Alabama. The Clerk of Court is DIRECTED to take the necessary steps to effectuate the terms of this Order.
