<sup>1</sup> Although the Recommendation does not address the fact that Plaintiff initially named a “Deputy John Doe” as a second defendant (Doc. # 1, at 1), Plaintiff did not pursue his claim against any deputies other than Kyler Williams. In fact, Plaintiff maintains that Williams was alone when Williams used his taser on Plaintiff. (See generally Doc. # 24.) Plaintiff thus cannot maintain an excessive force claim against any other deputies. (See Doc. # 4, at 1 n.1.)
