ORDER

On January 13, 2020, the Magistrate Judge filed a Recommendation (Doc. # 17) to which no timely objections have been filed. Upon an independent review of the record and upon consideration of the Recommendation, it is ORDERED as follows:

- (1) The Recommendation of the Magistrate Judge (Doc. # 17) is ADOPTED;
- (2) Petitioner’s 28 U.S.C. § 2255 (Doc. # 1) is DENIED as untimely under the limitation period in 28 U.S.C. § 2255(f); and
- (3) This action is DISMISSED with prejudice.

A separate final judgment will be entered.

A certificate of appealability will not be issued. For a petitioner to obtain a certificate of appealability, she must make “a substantial showing of the denial of a constitutional right.” 28 U.S.C. § 2253(c)(2). This showing requires that “reasonable jurists could debate whether (or, for that matter, agree that) the petition should have been resolved in a different manner or that the issues presented were adequate to
