MEMORANDUM OPINION

The magistrate judge filed a report on September 13, 2019, recommending that this action be dismissed without prejudice. Doc. 12. After Moten failed to do so, the magistrate judge recommended dismissing the case without prejudice for lack of prosecution. Doc. 12. Although the magistrate judge advised Moten of his right to file specific written objections within fourteen days, *id.*, no objections have been received by the court.

Having carefully reviewed and considered *de novo* all the materials in the court file, including the report and recommendation, the magistrate judge's report is hereby **ADOPTED** and the recommendation is **ACCEPTED**. In accordance with
