ORDER

The Court acknowledges receipt of Defendants’ motion to compel. (Doc. 10.) It appears to the Court that Defendants’ motion may well be amenable to resolution in whole or in part by agreement of counsel.

It is therefore ORDERED that counsel for the respective parties shall confer within eleven (11) days and shall attempt to resolve their differences or reduce the areas of dispute regarding the discovery request(s) at issue in the motion presently pending before the Court. The Court will hear argument and rule upon the motion ONLY if moving counsel files a statement with the Court certifying that after personal consultation and sincere efforts to do so, counsel have been unable to resolve the matter satisfactorily. Unless such a statement is filed on or before June 7, 2012, the

Court shall consider the motion moot and enter an order to that effect. If such a statement is filed on or before June 7, 2012, the Court will hear argument and rule upon the motion at 9:00 a.m. on Wednesday, June 13, 2012, in Courtroom 5B, Hugo L. Black United States Courthouse, 1729 5th Avenue North, Birmingham, AL. A court reporter will be present.

**Counsel are reminded that the Court *will* impose sanctions against the losing party in accordance with Fed. R. Civ. P. 37(a)(5), in the absence of substantial justification for the losing party's position.**
