**DECLARATION UNDER PENALTY OF PERJURY OF
REV. MARK JOHNSTON**


I, Mark Johnston, hereby declare under penalty of perjury that the matters contained in this declaration are true and accurate to the best of my knowledge and belief. I am over the age of 19 years and otherwise competent to testify under oath. I have personal knowledge of the matters contained in this declaration. This declaration is submitted in support of a motion for preliminary injunction filed by Plaintiffs in Case No. 5:11-CV-2736-CLS, styled *Rt. Rev. Henry N. Parsley, Jr., etc., et al., v. Robert Bentley, etc., et al.*

I am the Executive Director of Camp McDowell in Nauvoo, Alabama. This camp and conference center for the Episcopal Church in the Diocese of Alabama provides summer camps and other activities for children and adults. The McDowell Environmental Center also provides outdoor learning experiences for school groups. Since 1948, people of all faiths and backgrounds have used our facilities to rest, learn, grow, worship, and play.

Camp McDowell routinely enters into contracts with individuals and groups. These contracts, both prospective and existing, provide for food and lodging for periods of time. Camp McDowell also utilizes contracts that contain liability release language. It is very important to us that those contracts be enforced and enforceable. If the Anti-Immigration Law is enforced, our contracts will be in jeopardy.

Camp McDowell is open to all persons regardless of their immigration status. A number of people who use Camp McDowell are Hispanic. We have reason to believe some of our guests may be undocumented. We do not check immigration documentation and do not intend to do so. We do not – and would not – refuse any person because he or she lacked legal immigration status.

I declare the foregoing is true and accurate to the best of my knowledge and belief. Further declarant sayeth not.
