

MEMORANDUM OPINION

On August 26, 2014, the petitioner in the above-styled cause filed a stipulation of dismissal. (Doc. 10). The petitioner has been released pursuant to an Order of Supervision. (Doc. 10, p. 4). Accordingly, the petitioner affirms that the issues raised in the petition for *habeas corpus* relief filed pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 2241 are moot.
