MEMORANDUM OPINION

On August 13, 2015, the petitioner filed the above-styled petition for writ of *habeas corpus*. Along with his petition, the petitioner filed a motion to proceed *in forma pauperis*. (Doc. 2). The petitioner was notified by the court that his motion to proceed *in forma pauperis* was denied and he was ordered to, within thirty days, pay the \$5.00 filing fee. (Doc. 3).
