MEMORANDUM OPINION


The magistrate judge entered a report on September 12, 2019, recommending the court grant Respondents' motion to dismiss as moot due to Petitioner's removal to Ecuador on May 31, 2019. (Doc. 20). Although the magistrate judge advised the parties of their right to file specific written objections within fourteen (14) days, no objections have been received by the court.¹
