

MEMORANDUM OPINION

The Magistrate Judge filed a Report and Recommendation on November 9, 2020, recommending this action be dismissed without prejudice for failing to state a claim upon which relief can be granted, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(b). (Doc. 11). Although the Magistrate Judge advised Plaintiff of his right to file specific written objections,¹ the court has received no objections.

Having carefully reviewed and considered *de novo* all the materials in the court file, including the Report and Recommendation, the Magistrate Judge’s Report is hereby **ADOPTED** and the Recommendation is **ACCEPTED**. Therefore, in accordance with 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(b), this action is due to be dismissed without prejudice for failing to state a claim upon which relief can be granted.
