MEMORANDUM OPINION

The magistrate judge entered a report on July 13, 2020, recommending that the court grant Respondents’ motion to dismiss this 28 U.S.C. § 2241 petition for writ of habeas corpus as moot due to Petitioner Dario Aceituno’s removal to Argentina on June 2, 2020. (Doc. 22). Although the magistrate judge advised Mr. Aceituno of his right to file specific written objections within fourteen days, the court has not received any objections.¹

Having carefully reviewed and considered *de novo* all the materials in the court file, including the report and recommendation, the court **ADOPTS** the magistrate judge’s report and **ACCEPTS** his recommendation. Accordingly, the
