ORDER

Magistrate Judge Harwell Davis entered a Report on June 21, 2012, recommending that petitioner’s 28 U.S.C. § 2255 petition be denied.¹ The parties were allowed fourteen days in which to file objections to the recommendations made by the magistrate judge.² The copy of the report and recommendation mailed to petitioner at his last known address was returned to the court as undeliverable, marked “Return to Sender–Not Here.”³ The Federal Bureau of Prisons website shows that petitioner was released from prison on October 21, 2011.⁴ To date, petitioner has neither provided the court with an updated address, nor filed objections to the report and recommendation.
