MEMORANDUM OF OPINION


The magistrate judge filed a report and recommendation on February 6, 2014, recommending that this action filed pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 be dismissed under 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(b) for failing to state a claim upon which relief may be granted. No objections were filed.¹

Failure to notify the Clerk may result in dismissal of your case without further notice.” (Doc. no. 1, at 1). Plaintiff has failed to notify the Clerk of any change in his address.
