MEMORANDUM OF OPINION

The magistrate judge filed a report and recommendation on October 6, 2015, recommending that this action filed pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1983 be dismissed under 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(b) for failing to state a claim upon which relief may be granted. (Doc. 10). The plaintiff was notified of her right to file objections to the report and recommendation within fourteen (14) days, but no objections have been received by the court.
