**MEMORANDUM OF OPINION**

The magistrate judge filed a report on February 27, 2017, recommending this action be dismissed without prejudice for failing to state a claim upon which relief can be granted, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(b)(1). (Doc. 8). Although the magistrate judge advised the plaintiff of his right to file specific written objections within fourteen days, no party has filed any objections.
