## **MEMORANDUM OPINION**

The magistrate judge filed a report on October 2, 2017, recommending this action be dismissed without prejudice, pursuant to 28 U.S.C. § 1915A(b)(1), for failing to state a claim upon which relief can be granted. (Doc.10). Although the magistrate judge advised the plaintiff of his right to file specific written objections within fourteen (14) days, the court has received no objections.<sup>1</sup>
