ORDER

This matter is before the Court on the Joint Motion for Release of Vessels (doc. 29) <sup>1</sup>filed by plaintiff, All Star Marine Towing, LLP, and Bulldog Sand & Gravel, Inc., as claimant and owner, or bareboat charterer of the vessels, Barges CM9B, ATM1001B, SEI2002BF, JSB306, JSB304, CIA147, AR801, AR816, MAC254B, CGB340, and CGB148, and their hulls, tackle, gear, appurtenances and accessories of whatever nature belonging thereto. Upon consideration, the parties’ joint request for release of the vessels is GRANTED as follows:

The vessels are to be released from arrest and Writs of Discharge for the Vessels CM9B, ATM1001B, SEI2002BF, JSB306, CIA147, AR801, AR816, and the MAC254B are to be immediately issued and served by the United States Marshal upon any substitute custodian
